#### **PREFACE**

This Bibliography compiled by the IIMI Headquarters Library and Documentation Service is a semi-annual computer produced listing of literature on irrigation management and related subjects selected from the Irrigation Management Information Network database.

This volume of the bibliography supplements earlier volumes, which were called the "IMIN Bibliography". It does not cover the literature on irrigation management exhaustively, but many significant writings across a spectrum of disciplines that address irrigation management are included and may stimulate interest among researchers, policy makers and extension workers.

Citations are arranged according to broad Dewey Decimal Classification divisions. Since the majority of the documents fall in the area of irrigation management, that subject has been further expanded by IIMI to better distinguish particular aspects.

Entries are arranged in alphabetical order of author and title within each category. Abstracts are included only where feasible. In addition to the categorical divisions, each citation has been assigned specific keyword and geographical terms, bringing together the citations on more specific topics regardless of the category in which they are located in the main body of the bibliography. Author and title indexes are included to facilitate access to the individual citations.

Citations include old as well as new documents since entries are added to the database as they are acquired by the collaborators rather than according to date of issue.

It is expected that the bibliography will assist those interested in irrigation management to locate a wide variety of materials on the subject. All the documents cited are housed in the collaborating institute(s) indicated by the location code.

Requests for searches, compilation of bibliographic information from the database and photocopying services may be addressed to the IIMI Headquarters Library and Documentation Service. IIMI will provide photocopies of non-copyright material available at headquarters, or help obtain documents through inter-library loan.
