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ABSTRACT

The Third International Conference on New Frontiers for Hazardous Waste Management was held at Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, September 10-13, 1989. The purpose of this conference was to examine the state of technology for the disposal of hazardous waste. Emphasis was placed on the presentation of papers that summarized important new technological developments and concepts with broad international application.

Sessions were held in the areas of : (1) Thermal Treatment, (2) Physical/Chemical Treatment, (3) Biological Treatment, (4) Land Disposal, (5) Solidification/Stabilization, (6) Waste Minimization, and (7) Waste Management.
